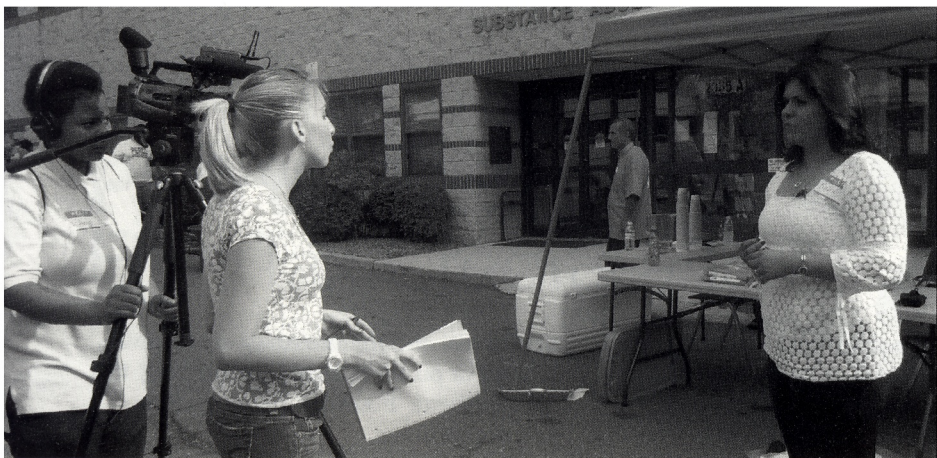

DOUBLE R LENDS A HAND TO "ALL HANDS ON DECK"

The intern team at Double R Productions shot and edited a pro bono video featuring businesses, volunteers, and members of the Economic Opportunities Commission giving the Alexandria Community Shelter a makeover. Double R captured the project on video to highlight "All Hands on Deck," a new program spearheaded by Allison Silberberg of the Economic Opportunities Commission that seeks to help a local non-profit each year that serves vulnerable residents of Alexandria.

To help the New Hope Housing shelter, Silberberg connected with Home Depot, which donated more than \$6,000 in supplies and brought home repair experts to work on the two-day project. Double R interns interviewed community leaders, volunteers, and shelter residents, all of whom pitched in to make the space feel like more of a home. In addition to shooting the video, Brittany Stanley, Linda Rubino, and Rory Manson joined other volunteers planting flowers, painting walls, and placing floorboards to improve the living conditions at the shelter. New Hope Housing, Home Depot, the Economic Opportunities Commission, and Alexandria Community Shelter will use the video to spread the word about "All Hands on Deck."
